TRAILHEADS / FREE PARKING

7th Avenue Trailhead: Located on 7th Avenue in Scranton between Lackawanna Avenue and Emmett Street.

Broadway Trailhead: Located on Broadway Street in Scranton between 3rd Avenue and South Washington Avenue.

Elm Street Trailhead: Located on Elm Street in Scranton between 3rd Avenue and South Washington Avenue.

The Central New Jersey (CNJ) Railroad Trail is part of the Lackawanna River Heritage Trail, a 70+ mile multi-use trail along the river from the New York State border to the Lackawanna River's confluence with the Susquehanna River in Pittston.

The CNJ Trail links to the Downtown Scranton Riverwalk trail section at the trailhead on 7th Avenue in Scranton. It follows the Lackawanna River south for just under one (.91) mile to Elm Street in South Scranton. The trail is finished with a crushed stone surface to allow a low

impact surface for walking, running, and biking. The South Side Sports Complex, located in the middle of the trail, provides trail users with a place to relax. The park is owned by the University of Scranton, and it has public restrooms, tennis courts, basketball courts, and a baseball field.

The CNJ Trail offers a different look of Scranton with lovely views of the Lackawanna River and chance encounters with wildlife along the trail.
